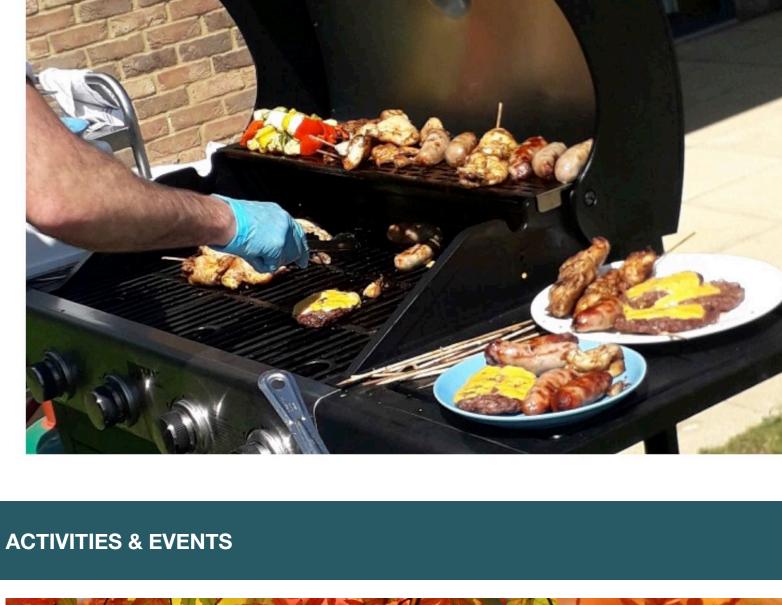
#### Music continues to bring joy and connection to everyone in our home, and it's always wonderful to see both residents and staff getting involved. Recently, we were

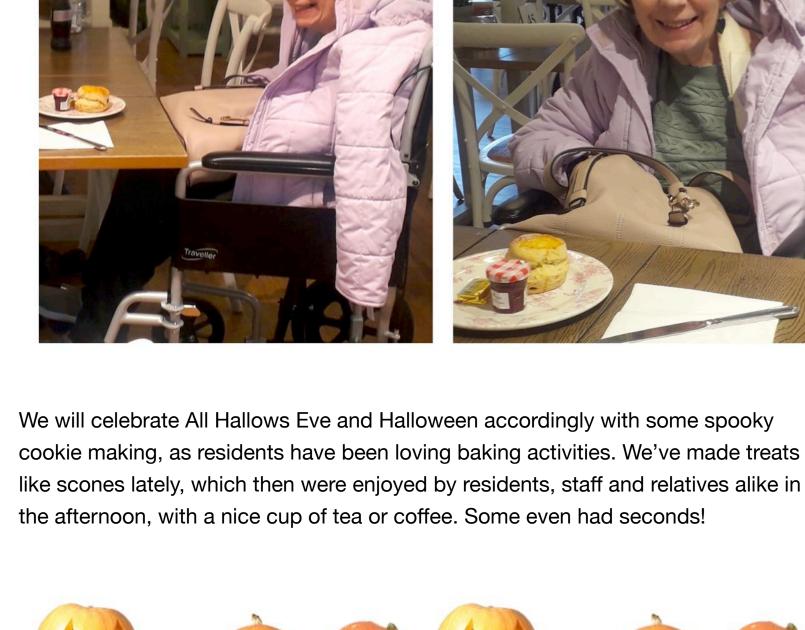

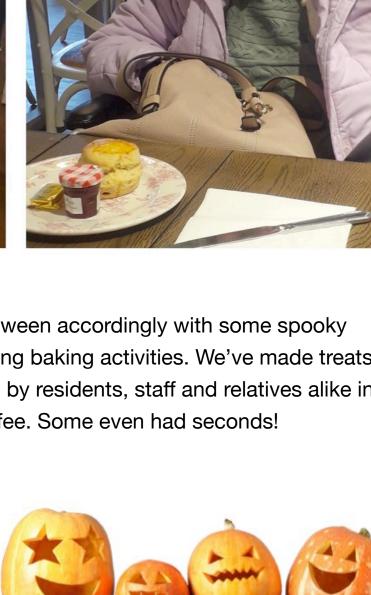

includes all five senses. Katy even rings a set of Tibetan bowls at the end of the

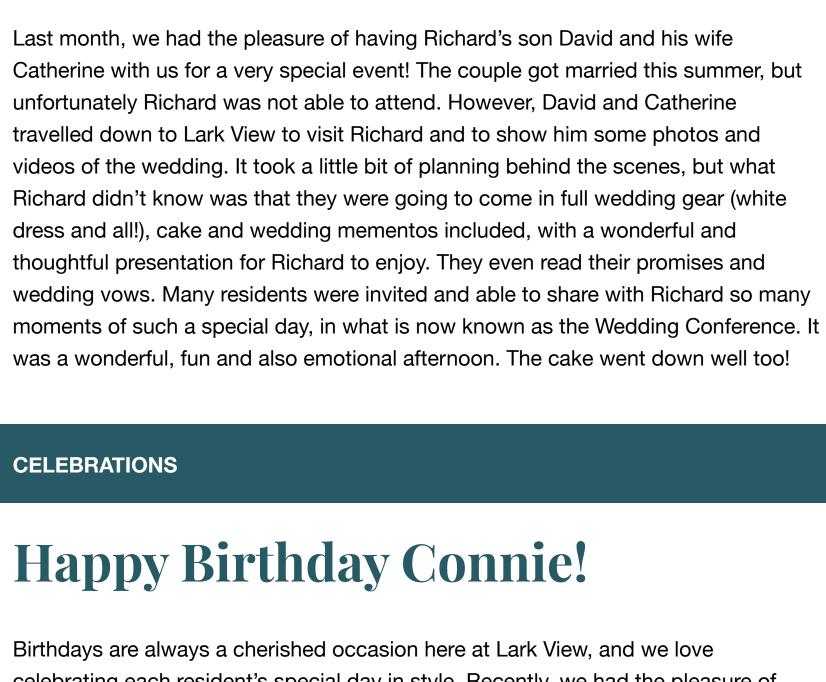

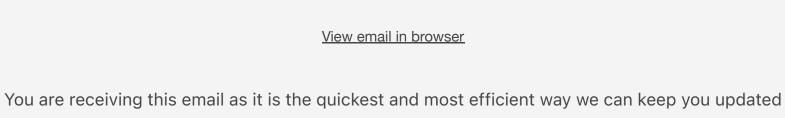
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
