Thank you to our staff for their continued dedication, and to our families and visitors for their ongoing support.

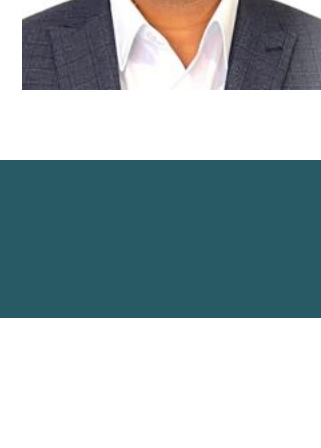

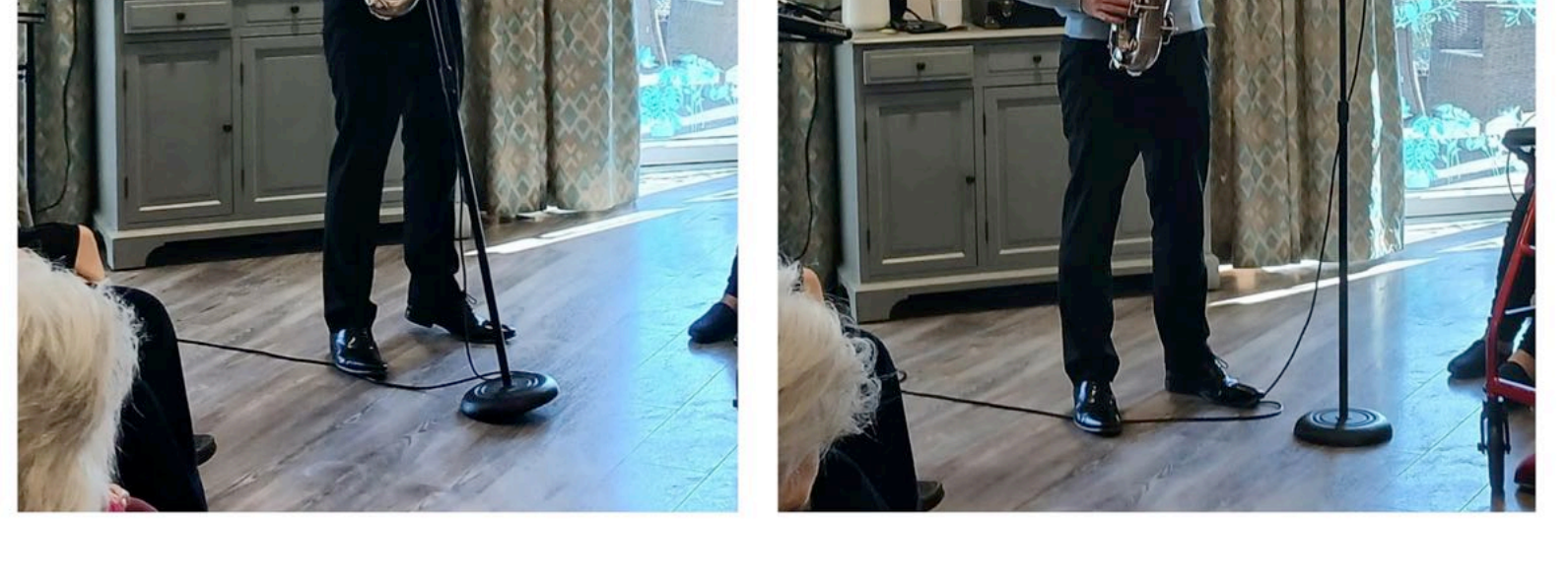


ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

Animal visits continue to be a valued part of our activity programme, offering comfort, enjoyment and a sense of connection.

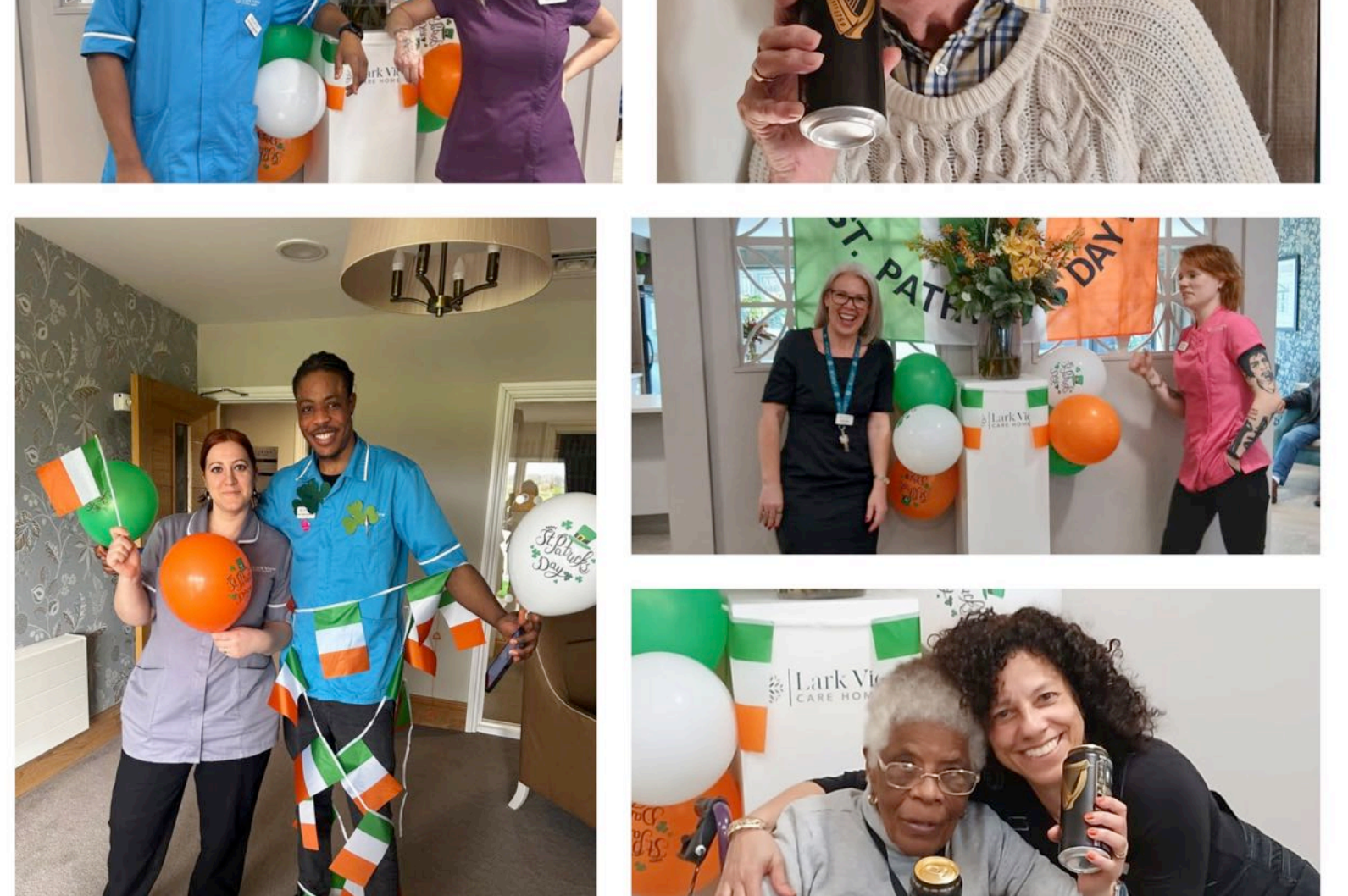


SEASONAL CELEBRATIONS

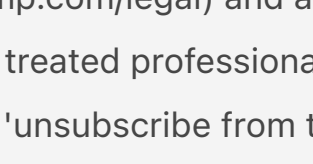
